IUD Benefits

For convenience, you may follow the instructions below to determine and understand your IUD benefits and your financial responsibility for IUD placement. The following is the information needed when calling your health insurance.

Doctors Name

Your Insurance ID

Insurance telephone number (usually found on back of ID card)

Things to ask your insurance company

- Is “contraception” a benefit of my insurance plan?
- Is IUD a benefit?
- Your insurance company will ask for a “procedure code”. The codes are as follows:
 - CPT code for Device
 - Mirena J7298
 - Paragard J7300
- What is your deductible?
- How much of your deductible has been met?
- Does deductible apply?
- What percent is covered?
- Does it need to be “pre-certified?”
- How much should I expect to bring with me the day of the procedure?

If your insurance does not cover an IUD, you may pay out of pocket for an IUD. Costs are as follows:

- Mirena IUD \$900.00
- Paragard IUD \$900.00
- Plus Insertion/Removal fee of \$95.00
